

SUBJECT: SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL

ORDER NO. SWD-152

THE APPLICATION OF RODNEY D. CALVIN FOR A
SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, (C) Rodney P. Calvin made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 20, 1973, for permission to complete for salt water disposal his Kaempf Well No. SWD-1 located 790 feet from the South line and 1500 feet from the West line of Section 19, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) of the Commission Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and the surface owners have been duly notified; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 (C) will be met.
4. That waivers of objection have been received from all offset operators and the surface owner.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant herein, Rodney P. Calvin is hereby authorized to complete his Kaempf Well No. SWD-1 located 790 feet from the South line and 1500 feet from the West line of Section 19, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Ojo Alamo formation at approximately 500 feet to approximately 575 feet through 2 1/16 inch tubing installed in a packer set in the 2 7/8 inch casing at approximately 475 feet. Provided further that cement shall be circulated on both the 5 1/2 inch surface casing and the 2 7/8 inch long string.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
