Order SWD- 280

Dear Mr. Smith,

Reference is made to your application dated July 17, 1985 for an amendment to Administrative Order SWD- 280, which authorized the use of your Wallaby "WZ" State Com No. 1 well to be used as a salt water disposal well, with injection taking place in the Cisco formation. The requested amendment proposes to change the injection formation to the Devonian formation for increased injectivity.

Since the following have been complied with:

1. That the amended application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all off-set operators and surface owners have been duly notified; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met.

Amoco Production Company is hereby authorized to complete it's North Baum Salt Water Disposal Well No. 1, (previously Wallaby "WZ" State Com No. 1), in a manner that will permit injection of salt water into the Devonian formation at approximately 12,900 feet to approximately 13,200 feet through 2 7/8 inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 9850 feet, and further, the injecting wellhead pressure shall be limited to 2580 psi.

The above amendment is authorized provided that all other directives contained in Administrative Order SWD-280 shall remain in effect.
