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APPLICATION OF MERIDIAN OIL, INC.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Meridian Oil, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on August 1, 1988, for permission to complete for salt water its San Juan 30-6 Unit SWD Well No. 2, located in Unit D, of Section 23, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

(1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations.

(2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified; and

(3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met.

(4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The applicant herein, Meridian Oil, Inc. is hereby authorized to complete its San Juan 30-6 Unit SWD Well No. 2 located in Unit D of Section 23, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Morrison and Entrada formations at approximately 7800 feet to approximately 8832 feet through 3 1/2-inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 7750 feet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

The operator shall take all steps necessary to ensure that the injected water enters only the proposed injection interval and is not permitted to escape to other formations or onto the surface.
