Dear Mr. Afghahi:

Reference is made to the Step Rate Injection Test Report for the above referenced well run on September 4, 2001. We recently found this test report in our well files WITHOUT a cover letter requesting an injection pressure increase. Despite this, we have reviewed the test results and feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

<i>Well and Location</i>	<i>Maximum Surface Injection Pressure</i>
C. A. Taylor Well No. 1	1585 PSIG
Located in Unit P of Section 11, Township 18 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers. This order is retroactive to October 1, 2001.
