I am writing this letter in reference to the NMF State #1 SWD that is operated by Sapient Energy Corp. A SWD permit was granted through "Administrative Order #726" on 10-13-98. A request for a maximum injection pressure increase was granted on 8-19-99. The completion report was filed on 8-16-99 and a C-104 was submitted on 8-29-99.

At the present time Sapient is injecting 400-450 BWPD into the Glorieta Formation through tubing with a packer set at 5150' and a CIBP set at 5850'. The NMF State #1 SWD services the producing wells in Warren Field. At this time the field is producing over 550' barrels a day and the excess water production is being hauled to a commercial disposal. Sapient requests that it be granted approval to add additional perforations to the Glorieta Formation in the well.

The proposed operations would be to pull the packer and perforate the Glorieta Formation from 4920'-5020'. A total of 40 net feet and 80 perforations would be shot. The perforated interval would be acidized and commingled with the existing perforations in the well. An MIT would be performed to insure tubing and casing integrity prior to reestablishing injection into the well.

There is no existing Glorieta production in the area.
