

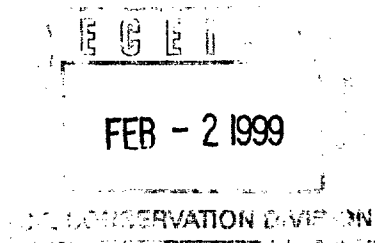

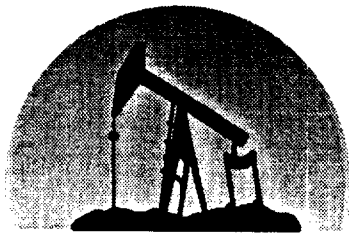

LEGAL NOTICE

Marbob Energy Corporation, Post Office Box 227, Artesia, New Mexico 88211-0227 has filed Form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking administrative approval for a salt water disposal well. The proposed well, the E. L. Federal #8 is located 380 feet from the south line and 990 feet from the east line, Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Disposal water will be sourced from area wells producing from the Seven Rivers, Grayburg, San Andres, and Yeso formations. The disposal water will be injected into the Yeso/Paddock formation at a depth 4710'-5128'. A maximum surface pressure of 942 psi, and a maximum rate of 10,000 BWP/D. Any interested party who has an objection to this must give notice in writing to the Oil Conservation Division, 19240 South Pacheco Street, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505 within fifteen (15) days of this notice. 
Dear Mr. Stone:

On January 21, 1999, Marbob Energy Corporation submitted for OCD approval an Application for Authorization to Inject concerning Marbob Energy's E.L. Federal No. 8 located in Unit P of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 30 East. This Application has not been approved in part due to an objection submitted by Mack Energy Corporation, an offset operator to the proposed disposal well. As a result from meeting with representatives for Mack Energy, we would respectfully request to amend the previously submitted Application in an effort to relieve concerns voiced by Mack Energy. Therefore, Marbob Energy Corporation proposed to amend the Application for Authorization to Inject for the E.L. Federal No. 8 to reflect a maximum of 2000 barrels per day limit be placed on this disposal well.
