Yates Petroleum Corporation, 105 South Fourth Street, Artesia, NM 88210, has filed Form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking administrative approval for an injection well. The proposed well, the "South Rock SWD, #1" located 1980' FSL & 660' FWL of Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 25 East of Eddy County, New Mexico, will be used for salt water disposal. Disposal waters from the Morrow will be re-injected into the Mississippian-Devonian at a depth of 10,870'-11,700' with a maximum pressure of 6522 psi and a maximum rate of 5,000 BWPD.
