Due to current additional development drilling and future water flooding plans, Belco herewith submits, under the provisions of Rule 309c, application for administrative approval of off lease storage of oil produced from the San Andres in the Flying "M" Pool, from the above described leases. A plat is attached illistrating the location of the central tank battery and the oil producing leases. Belco has a surface use lease with Annette Martin, Lubbock, Texas, for SESE 31, T9S, R33E - the battery site.
