Re: Surface Commingling and Off Lease Storage Lease Nos. V-1952, V-1981 and L-1648-3

Reference is made to your letter of January 1, 1992, wherein you have requested our approval to surface commingle production from Lease Nos. V-1952 and V-1981 and off-lease store this production on Lease No. L-1648-3.

We have derived the following information from your application:

- Ray Westall, as operator, has the approval of all individual interest owners, all approving the proposed commingling and off-lease storage.
- 2. Production from two wells, the Myrtle Myra Well No. 1 (Lease No. V-1981) and Mytrle Myra Well No. 3 (Lease No. V-1952), will be commingled into a common tank battery stored on State Lease No. L-1648-3.
- 3. It is our understanding the Production from the Myrtle Myra Well No. 3 (Lease No. L-1648) will be separately metered and will not be commingled with the production from other wells.

Since it appears that there will be no loss of revenue to the State of New Mexico as a result of your proposed operation, your request for surface commingling and off-lease storage operations is hereby approved. Any deviation from the substance of your request will be sufficient grounds for rescinding our approval. Our approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

Dear Mr. LeMay:

Ray Westall Operator Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval to commingle production from two wells drilled on two-leases into a common tank battery and to permit the production from one lease to be transported prior to measurement to another lease for storage there on. It is proposed to commingle the production from the Myrtle Myra #1 and the Myrtle Myra #3 into a common storage facility located on the Myrtle Myra #2 location. A map labeled Attachment I is enclosed for your information.

The purpose of this off lease storage and surface commingling and treating and is to reduce operating cost for storage thereby extend the economic life of each well. Without approval for utilizing existing batteries on adjacent leases, it will become necessary to build separate facilities for This will greatly increase costs and shorten economic life of the well. Because working interests royalty interests are the same in both leases we will assign a semi-annual GOR factor to each well based on tests. production in both wells is from the same producing zone which is the Delaware Formation. In accordance with the referenced 303-B, 309-B and 309-C, the following diagrams, maps and well data are submitted for your information.
