Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval for an exception to Rule 309-A to permit commingling of production from two leases, Chevron's Lea "TZ" State and Lea "UA" State. The Lea "TZ" State Well #5 was completed in the South East Scharb Wolfcamp in March, 1985. Permission was received from the OCD, Hobbs District Office, to temporarily commingle the Wolfcamp production from Well #5 with the Wolfcamp production at the Lea "UA" State Battery, located in Section 16-T19S-R35E, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. states the following facts:

1. All production is from a common source, the Wolfcamp.
2. All wells will be tested monthly to determine correct production allocation.
3. A letter of consent was received from the purchaser and is attached.
4. Permission to commingle will prevent waste and unnecessary production expense by eliminating the need to construct a new tank battery.

Also included with this application is a battery schematic, diagraming the test and production facilities, and a lease plat to reference the location.

In view of the facts submitted, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. requests that administrative approval of the lease commingling be granted.

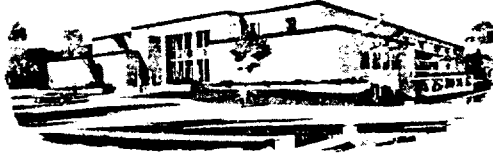

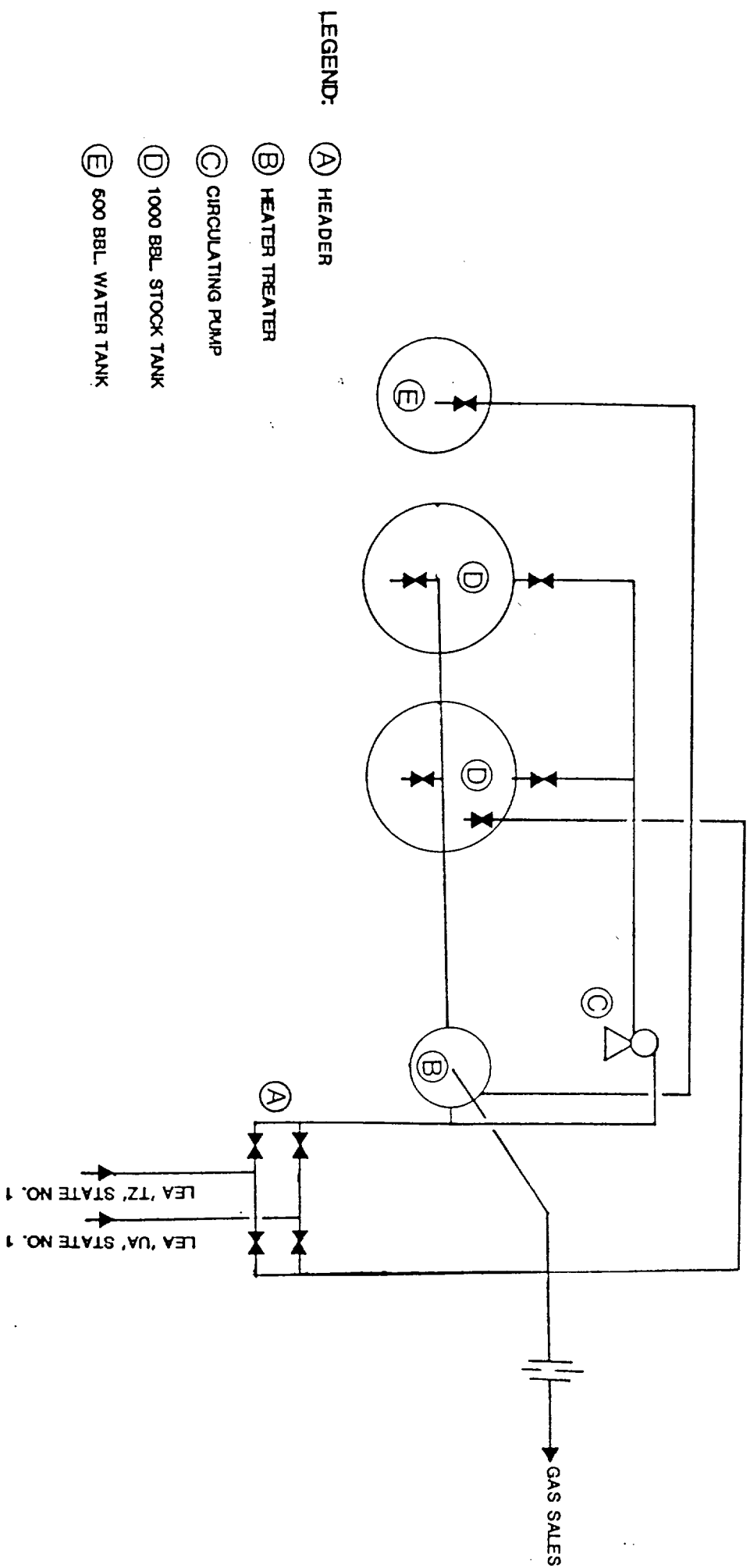

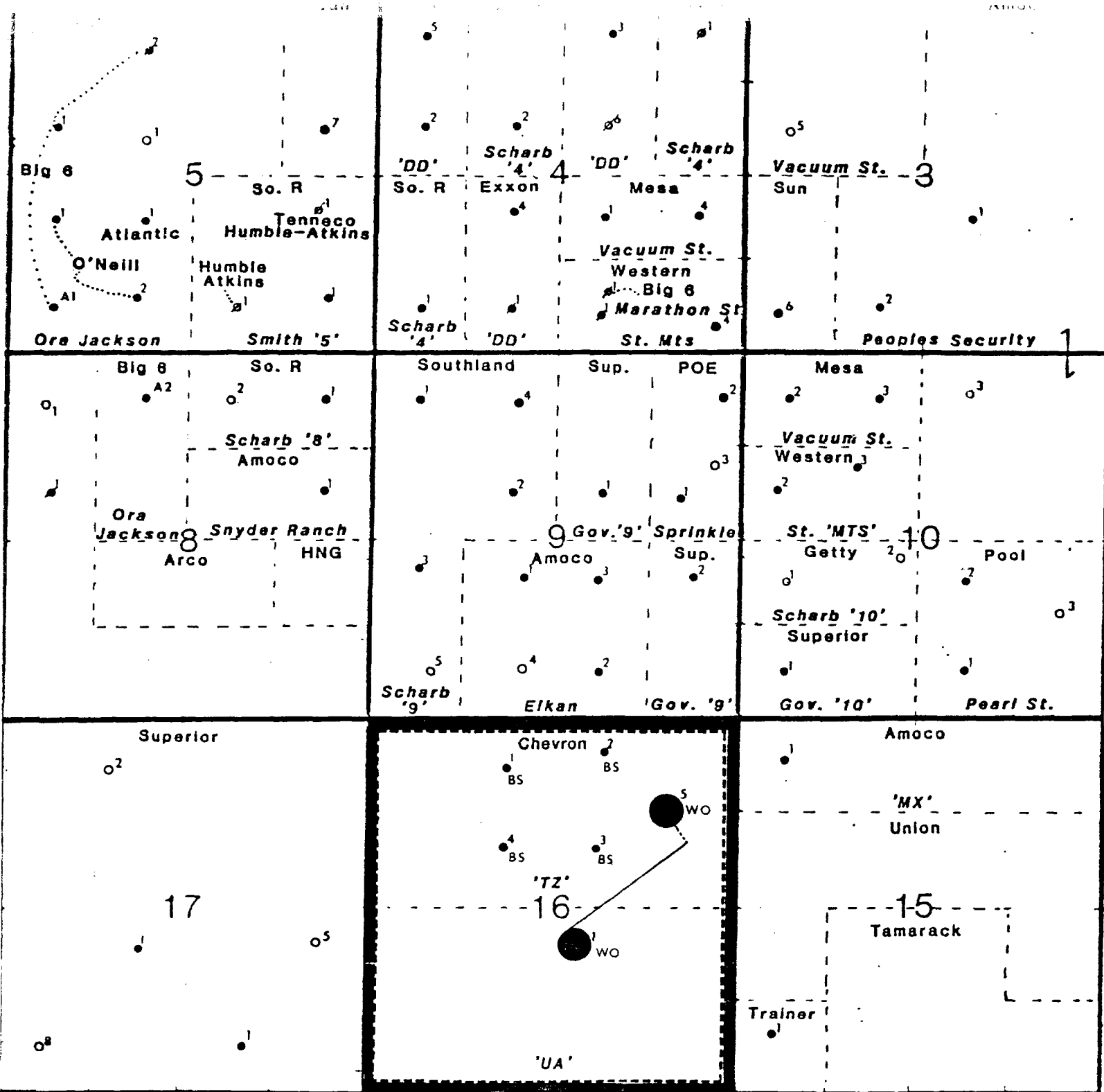
