Conoco Inc. requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 309-B to surface commingle production from the State S-19 No. 4 with production from State S-19 No. 3 and the State 19 Lease. All production is from the Empire Abo Pool, and would be commingled at the State 19 Battery which is located in SE/4 SW/4 of Sec. 19, T17S, R29E.

Royalty interests are common between the two properties, and there are no overriding royalty interests. The working interests would have also been common between the two properties, but Inexco Oil Company, one working interest owner, went non-consent in drilling the No. 4 well. After State S-19 No. 4 pays out and the penalty is recouped by the consenting working interest owners, Inexco will back in as a working interest owner. Therefore, we plan to allocate production based on well tests.

Our proposed battery schematic and lease plat is enclosed for your information. In addition, the attached letters to Conoco Transportation and the working interest owners will serve as notification to all parties involved of our commingling proposal. Exxon's approval of the proposed commingling project, which is required by the Commissioner of Public Lands, is also attached.

Please note an application of this commingling proposal is also being made with the Commissioner of Public Lands.






