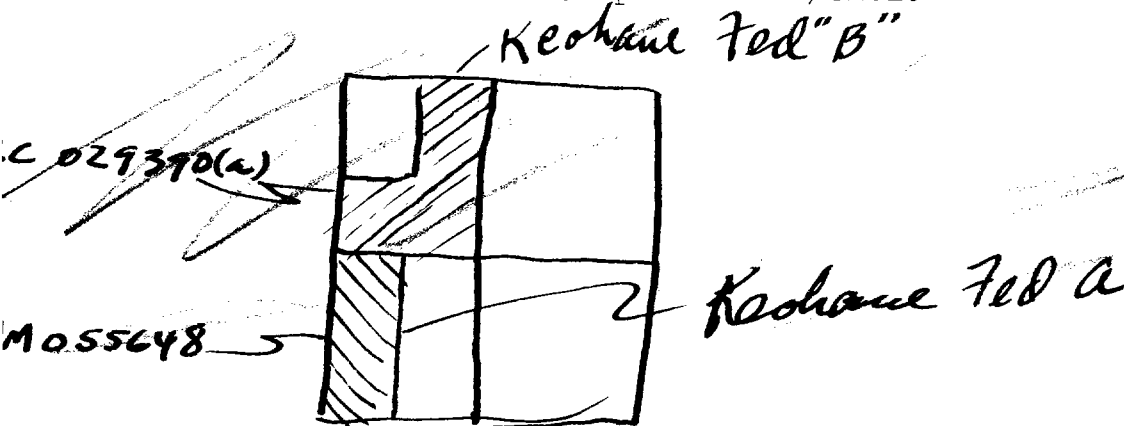
We sincerely hope that you have found everything in order and that you will be able to issue the Order approving the commingling administratively in the very near future.

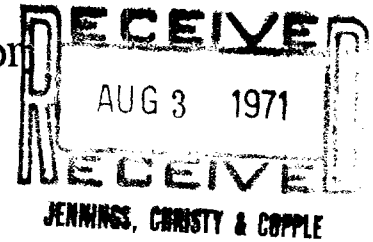

Gentlemen:

Your letter of July 13, 1971 requests approval to commingle Grayburg and San Andres production from leases Las Cruces 029020(a), Las Cruces 029020(c), and New Mexico 0467930, with the commingling facility to be located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 22, T. 17 S., R. 30 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

For royalty purposes, production allocation to individual leases will be based on periodic well tests. The monthly production for each well and subsequently each lease, as reported on Lessee's Monthly Report of Operations, form 9-329, will be based on these well tests. The Lessee's Monthly Report of Sales and Royalty, form 9-361, must show all computations used in the calculation of lease sales.

The method of commingling described by your application is hereby approved subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. Notify the District Engineer, U. S. Geological Survey, Post Office Drawer U, Artesia, New Mexico 88210, when the installation is completed and operative so that it can be inspected.

Simultaneous herewith, we are furnishing a copy of the Application to the U.S.G.S. and are requesting its approval. When the approval is received, we will forward it to you.

We are also requesting approval of the pipeline purchaser to the commingling and this too will be furnished to you.

The ownership of the three federal leases is common and a list of the overriding royalty owners is attached to the Application as Exhibit "B". A copy of this Application is being forwarded to each of the overriding royalty owners today by certified mail.

By Order No. R-4133 in Case No. 4521, the Applicant was authorized to institute a waterflood project and the installation of a common tank battery.

2. That all production from the leases is from a common source of supply in the Premier Zone of the Grayburg Formation and the Grayburg-Jackson Zone of the San Andres Formation, and that adequate facilities will be provided for accurately determining the production from each well at reasonable intervals.

3. That in support of this application and in accordance with the provisions of Rule 309-B, Applicant submits herewith the following exhibits:

A - Plat of the leases showing the wells thereon, the formation in which they have been completed, and the location of the proposed tank battery and flowlines.

4. That the Applicant is the operator and owner of the working interest production from the leases and that the ownership of all production from the leases is common throughout. That a list of the owners of the overriding royalty interest under the leases is attached hereto and marked Exhibit B, and that simultaneous with the filing of this application, Applicant is notifying all parties by certified mail of its application for permission to commingle production from the separate leases.

5. That Leases LC 029020(a), NM 0467930 and LC 029020(c) were originally a part of the same prospecting permit and the leases have identical Schedule "C" royalty provisions, and that a copy of this application is being filed with the United States Geological Survey, Roswell, New Mexico, and upon receipt of approval of commingling from the United States Geological Survey the approval will be filed with the Commission.

6. That by Order No. R-4133 in Case No. 4521 entered April 14, 1971, the Applicant was authorized to institute a

waterflood project designated as the Shenandoah Grayburg-Jackson Parke Waterflood Project. That the installation of a common tank battery will be in the interest of conservation and prevent waste.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Secretary-Director of the Commission approve the commingling of production from the wells located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M. under Lease LC 029020(a) with the wells located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, N $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M. on Lease NM 0467930, and with the wells on Lease LC 029020(c) located on the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M. into a common tank battery to be located on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M.
