

Gentlemen:

Approval is being sought for off-lease storage for production from the Millard Deck Oil Company State WE "D" No. 1 located in the NE/4 - SE/4 of Section 27, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is proposed that for the convenience of the oil and gas pipelines that tank battery facilities be constructed in the SW/4 - NW/4 Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 36 East. An oil and gas pipeline connection is available at the Federal "D" battery but it would require that oil and gas pipelines be laid to a battery on the State WE "D" location. Due to the low oil and gas production rate the pipelines were reluctant to make that expenditure. This proposal is being made in the interest of providing the most beneficial and economical method of producing oil and gas which is needed by the consumer and it will also be providing revenue for the State of New Mexico in the form of royalty and severance taxes.

Our application for off-lease storage follows:

- 1. Production from the State WE "D" lease is all from one well producing in the Eumont Yates Seven Rivers Queen field.
- 2. There is no intercommunication possible until the oil and gas is placed into the respective pipeline gathering systems.
- 3. There will be completely separate handling and storage facilities for the State WE "D" lease and the Federal "D" lease.
- 4. All parties owning either a working interest or a royalty interest have been sent copies of applications mailed to the United States Department of the Interior and the Commissioner of Public Lands by certified mail. A copy of the certified mail receipts are attached.
- 5. This off-lease storage proposal has been approved by both the United States Department of the Interior and the Commissioner of Public Lands. Copies of their approval letters are attached.


