Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of April 24, 1964, wherein you request authority for off-lease storage for your Ellen Weir Lease which comprises the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, North Cass Tubb Pool.
