


6. Form C-102 reflecting ownership of the subject leases, wells, formations, and location of the tank battery is attached to this application.

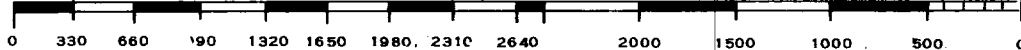
