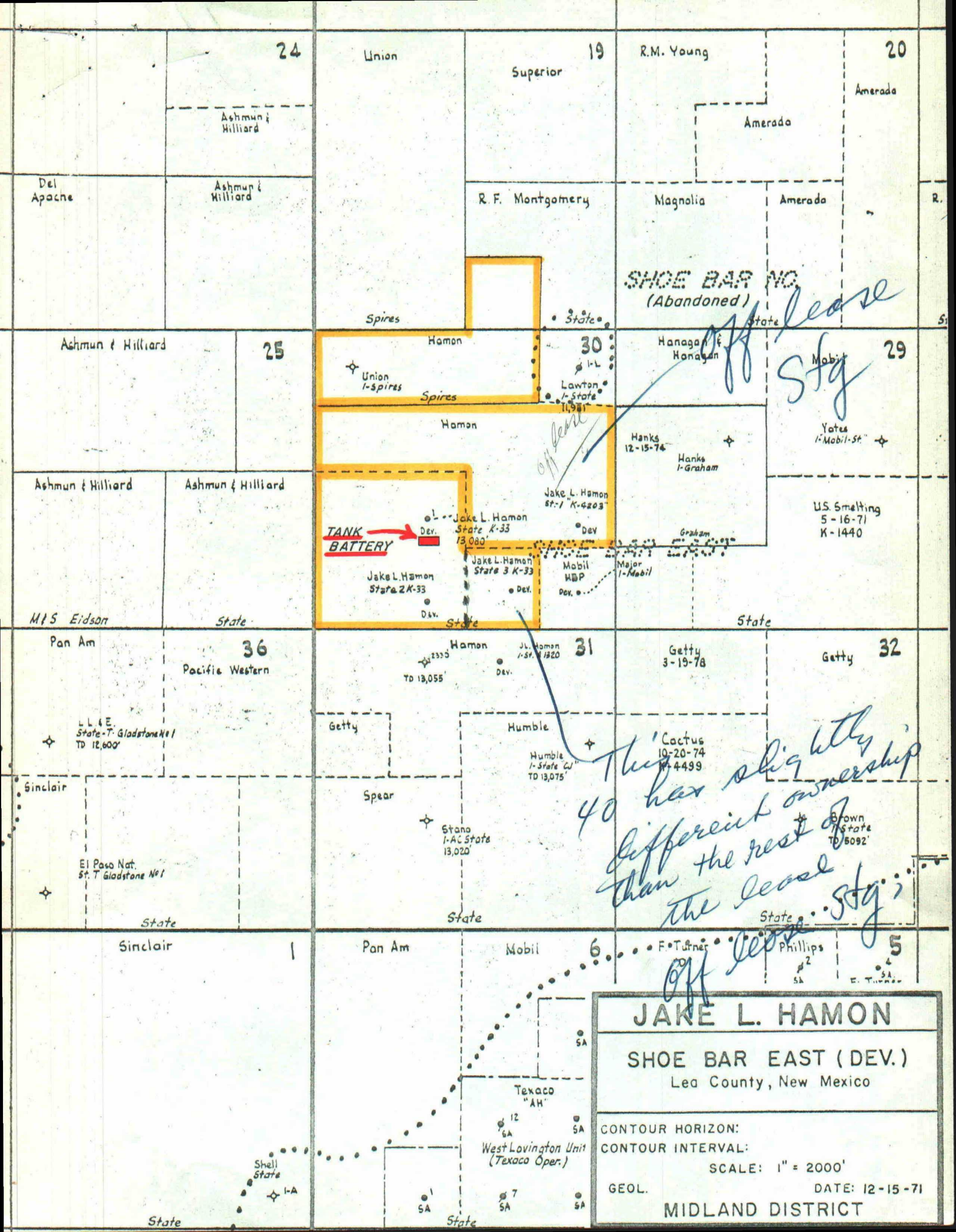

Dear Dan:

This will refer to my letter of December 24 and our telephone conversations relative to the application of Jake L. Hamon to commingle the production from the Hamon Wells State 1 and 2 - K-33 and State 3-K-33 situated in the East Shoe Bar-Devonian Pool. They first advised me that they would go ahead and install the necessary meters to comply with the applicable regulations, but late yesterday afternoon Cecil Barton called from the Midland office and advised that after further consideration it would be just as cheap or cheaper to add additional storage for the production from State 3 - K-33 as it would be to install the necessary meters and samplers for the purpose of commingling.

This will serve to withdraw the application which we filed on behalf of Mr. Hamon for commingling and you need not give the same further consideration.
