Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated March 9, 1972, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309 of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit off-lease storage for Empire-Abo production from your State Well No. 2, located in Unit P of Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you propose to construct a tank battery for this well on the Chambers and Kennedy Lease in Unit N of Section 27, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, in order to obtain a pipeline connection for the well.

Penroc is hereby authorized off-lease storage for the subject well as described above, provided that there shall be no inter-communication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities designated to each lease.

Proposed tank battery to be located in Unit N, Section 27, T-17-S, R-28-E, as depicted by the enclosed plat.


The reasons for this request are to get a pipe line connection from Amoco Pipeline Company with an eleven cent per barrel increase in the price of oil, and to move a greater distance from Mountain States telephone equipment preventing possible corrosion from sour gas.

All production is from the Abo Reef formation. Commingling of production will not result at any stage prior to entering Amoco's line.

Enclosed are plats of the proposed battery, lease ownership and well information, and a letter giving permission from the other lease owner.

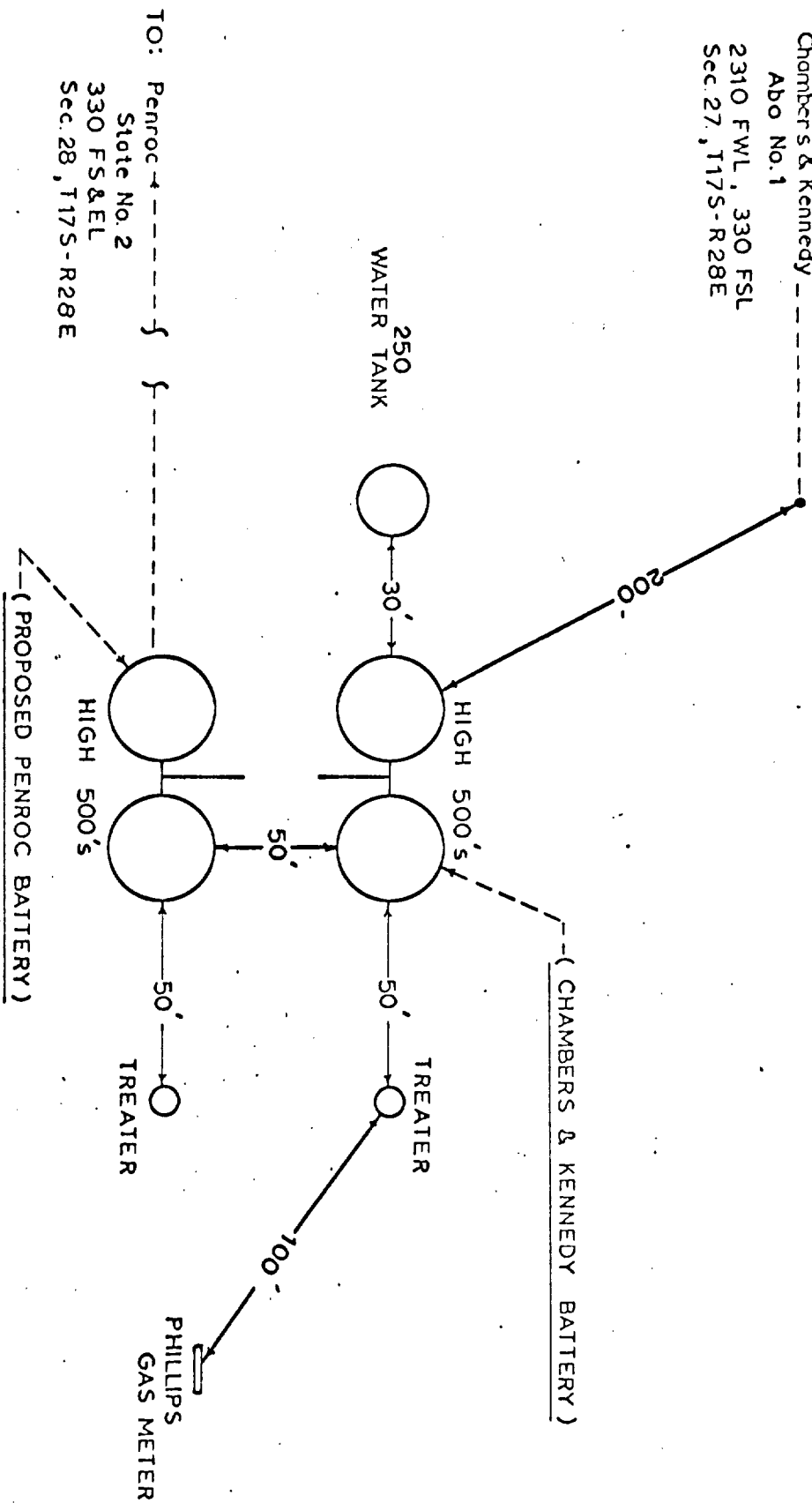

# Request For Off Lease Oil Storage 27 Unit N, T17S - R28E Empire Abo Field

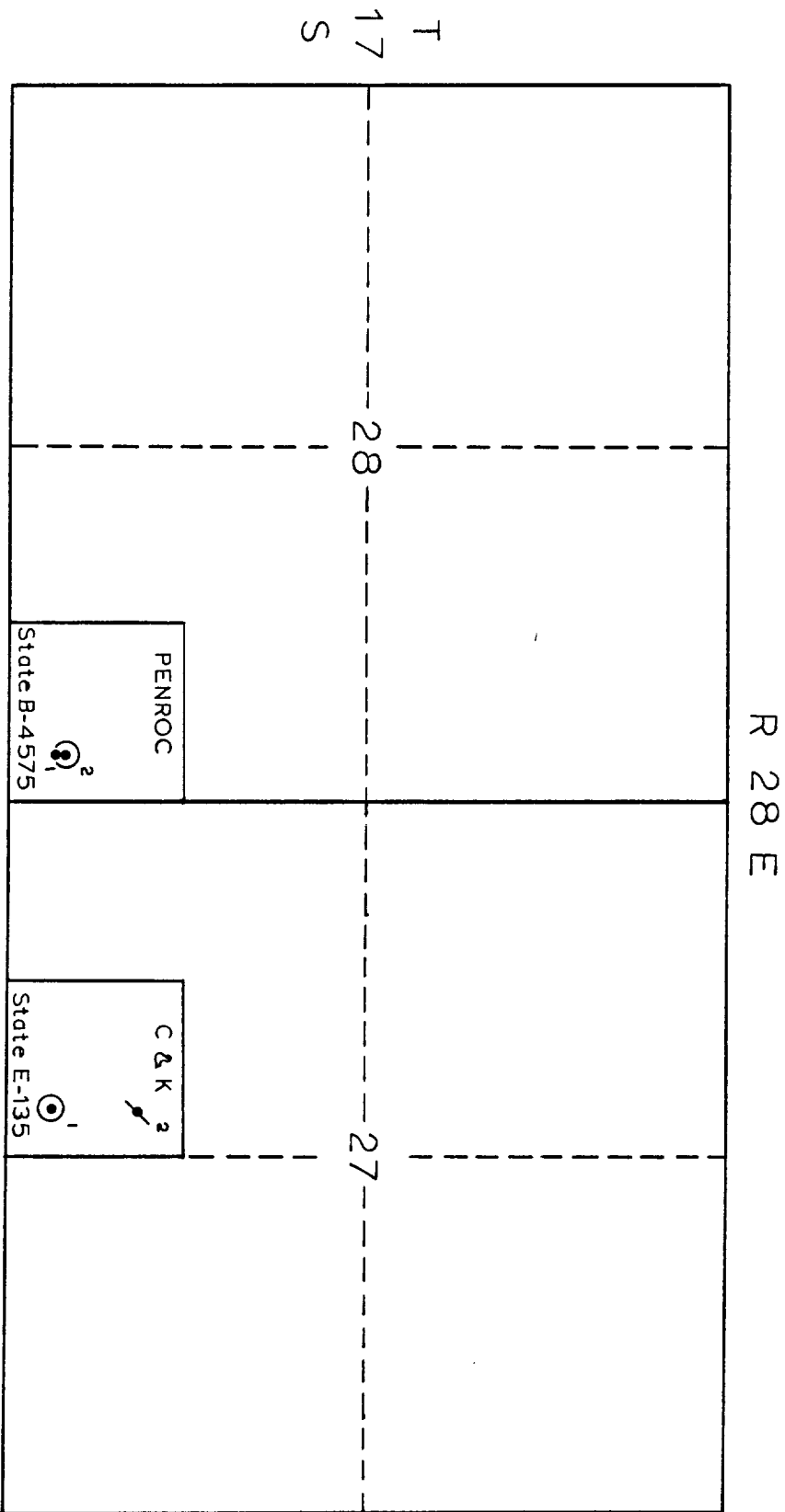
