Gentlemen:

Enclosed please find plat referencing our Lane "B" 674-Ltd Lease Section 1-10S-33E and our Sunray Lease Sec. 36-9S-33E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Maurice L. Brown Company has recently re-entered the Lane "B" #3 and is presently completing pump tests. Pump tests indicate a commercial well and a tank battery to handle liquids from this well is required. We have purchased an abandoned tank battery which is erected at approximately the SE SW of Section 36-9S-33E.

We request the Commission to grant an exception to Rule 309-A and permit us to use this tank battery for the produced fluids from the Lane "B" #3.

All production is from the Bough formation. Commingling of production from these two leases will not result as the Sunray Lease has its individual tank battery. The Maurice L. Brown Company is the operator of both leases.

This facility is completely independent of Sunray #3 which is producing to an individual tank battery located C NE SW of Section 36-9S-33E. This battery has water disposal lines connected, oil and gas pipelines available and it is desirous to have these facilities at a reasonable distance from the proposed Lane tank battery installation.

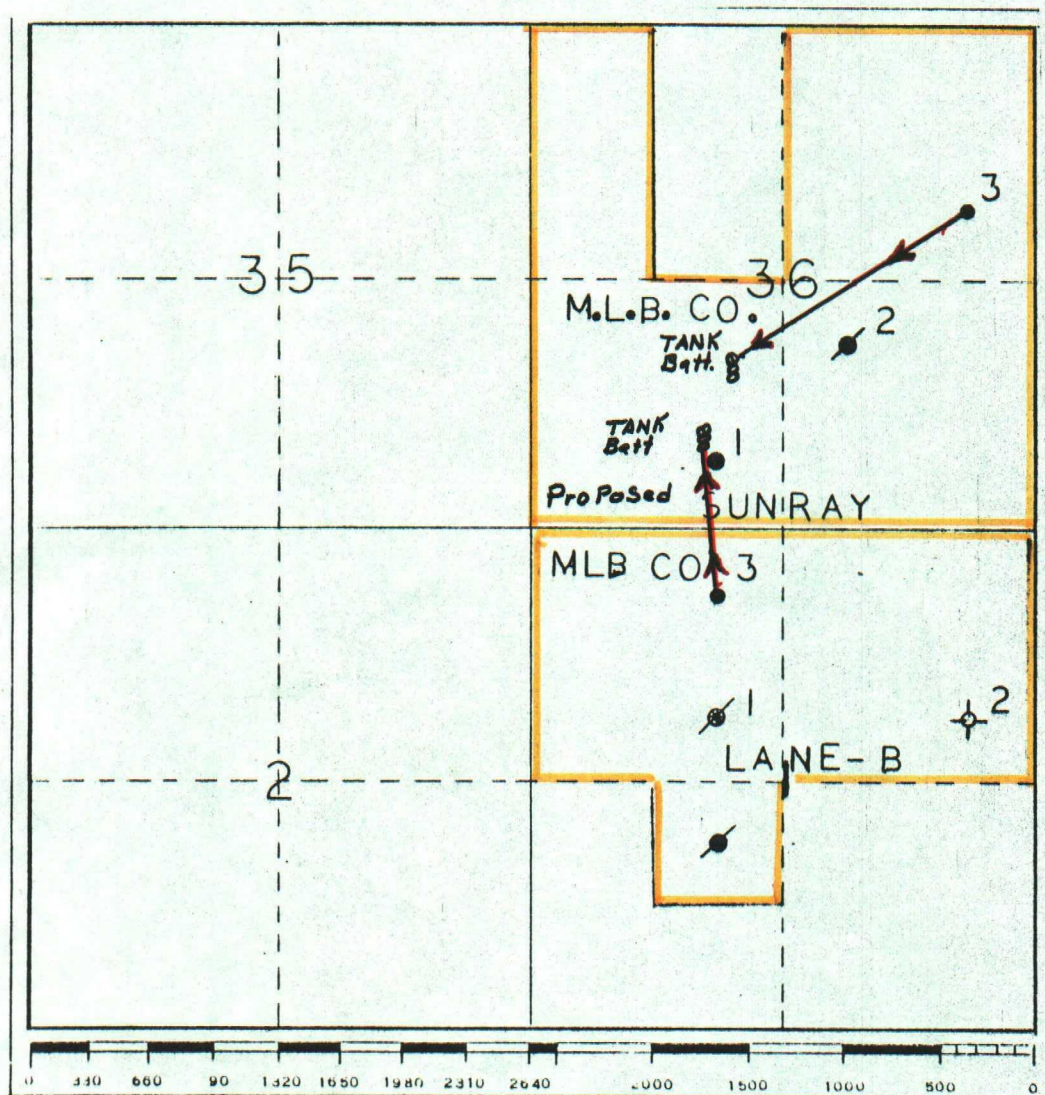
