Gentlemen:

Administrative Order PC No. 1 granted TEXACO Inc. exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission to permit the commingling of the oil produced from the Moore Wolfcamp Pool and the Moore Pennsylvanian Pool from all wells presently or hereafter drilled on TEXACO Inc.'s State "BN" (NCT-1) lease comprising the SW/4 of Section 25, T-11-S, R-32-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. However, the commingling was not effected since workover was not successful in obtaining Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian production from the only well on the subject lease prospective for such production. This well is the State of New Mexico "BN" (NCT-1) Well No. 1. The Wolfcamp produced 100 percent water and re-entry to obtain Pennsylvanian production would not payout.

TEXACO Inc. appreciates having received permission to commingle the above described production. But, since workover was unsuccessful and TEXACO Inc. does not anticipate future drilling for either Wolfcamp


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or Pennsylvanian production, it is hereby requested
that Administrative Order PC No. 1 be cancelled.
