Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated March 28, 1960, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission to permit the commingling of the oil produced from the Blinebry, Ellenburger, Fusselman, McKee, Montoya, and Drinkard formations in the Justis Field from all wells located on your A. B. Coates "C" and "D" leases comprising the following-described acreage:

Coates "C" Lease, E/2, SE/4 NW/4 and NE/4 SW/4,
Section 24, Township 25 South, Range 37 East

Coates "D" Lease, SE/4 SW/4, Section 24, Township
25 South, Range 37 East

all in Lea County, New Mexico.
