

We are currently running the production from your A. B. Coates "C" and "D" leases, located in E/2; SE/4 of NW/4; NE/4 of SW/4 and the SE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 24-T25S - R37E, Justis-Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
