Administrative Order PC-9

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of November 1, 1965, wherein you have requested an amendment to Administrative Order PC-9 which authorizes the commingling of Justis-Blinebry, Justis-Tubb, and Justis-Drinkard production on your Arnott Ramsay "F" Lease which comprises the N/2 of Section 36, Township 25 South, Range 37 Mast, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately measuring the production from each pool. It is our understanding that you now propose to commingle Fusselman and Tubb-Drinkard production on said lease after separately metering each and that Blinebry and Langlie-Mattix production will each be handled separately. We are now in receipt of the revised schematic diagram for your proposed installation which is in conformance with the Commission commingling manual.

Administrative Order PC-9 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Justis-Fusselman and Justis Tubb-Drinkard production on the subject lease after separately metering each. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made prior to putting it in operation.
