Amendment Administrative Order PC-21

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of May 12, 1965, wherein you advise that your A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Well No. 25 is capable of producing top allowable from both the Tabb and Drinkard zones, and that said well is connected to the tank battery authorized for commingling by Administrative Order PC-21; said order was amended January 4, 1965 to authorize commingling of production from the Drinkard, Tubb, and Tubb Gas Pools without separate measurement inasmuch as all production was at that time of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-21 is hereby further amended to permit the commingling of production from the Tubb, Drinkard, and Tubb Gas Pools after separately measuring each with positive displacement meters and fluid samplers as provided for originally in Order PC-21.
