
Dear Mr. Porter:

We request Administrative Order PC-25 of December 2, 1960 be cancelled. This order approved commingling of oil production from the Caudill-Wolfcamp (Caudill Permo Penn) and the Caudill-Devonian Pool from all wells on the D. H. Crockett Lease comprising the NE/4 and the E/2 NW/4 of Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, NE/4, Lea County, New Mexico. D. H. Crockett, Well No. 1, Caudill-Devonian Pool, Unit C, Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, was abandoned February 18, 1963 due to economic limit.

The remaining wells, D. H. Crockett, Well No. 1, Unit C, Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, and D. H. Crockett, Well No. 2, Unit B, Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 37 East, produce from the Caudill-Wolfcamp (Caudill Permo Penn) Pool.
