Amendment Administrative Order PC-29

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated June 30, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-29 to permit the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard production on that portion of your A. H. Blinebry NCT-1 Lease comprising the N/2 N/2 of Section 29, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and Blinebry, Drinkard, and Tubb gas pool condensate from that portion of said lease comprising the S/2 NW/4 of Section 29, after separately metering the production from each pool and from each portion of said lease.

It is our understanding that the separate measurement of the production from each portion of the lease is necessary because of a difference in the Federal royalty interest rate applicable to each portion of the lease.

Administrative Order PC-29 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of the aforesaid production on said lease in the above-described manner.
