

Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests revision of Administrative Order PC-29 to authorize the commingling of production between diversified ownership as well as between zones on that portion of the A. H. Blinebry NCT-1 Lease that is comprised of the N/4 and S/2 NW/4 of Section 29, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. Order PC-29 granted authority to commingle production from the Blinebry Pool, Drinkard Pool and Tubb Gas Pool, after separately metering each, on the aforesaid portion of the subject lease.

At the time when Order PC-29 was issued, April 6, 1961, the only production from the aforesaid lease portion was being obtained from wells located in the portion comprised of the S/2 NW/4 of said section. Subsequently, production has been obtained from the N/4 of said section. The Federal royalty interest rate on the N/4 of Section 29 is different from the royalty interest rate on the S/2 NW/4 of said Section 29.

Therefore, the requested revision of Order PC-29 is for permit to commingle after separately measuring each of the Blinebry and Drinkard zone production on the N/4 of Section 29 and separately measuring each of the Blinebry, Drinkard, and Tubb (Gas) zone production from the S/2 NW/4 of Section 29. All measuring shall be performed



with temperature compensated positive displacement meters with fluid samplers, all of an approved kind. Attached is a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed comingling installation. A copy of this requested revision has been sent to the United States Geological Survey at Box 1857, Roswell, New Mexico.



A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Sec. 29 Lease Portion




Gentlemen:

It is respectfully requested that the amendment, dated September 4, 1964, to Administrative Order No. PC-29 be cancelled. Administrative Order PC-29 authorized commingling of production between zones, contained in a portion of the A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Lease, in the area consisting of the N/2 N/2 and S/2 NW/4 of Section 19, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The amendment, dated September 4, 1964, authorized expansion of the area to include the S/2 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, also a portion of the A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Lease.

After the commingling area was authorized for expansion, a different low pressure gas sales contract was negotiated that resulted in a higher gas value being realized if the gas produced from the wells completed in the S/2 of Section 20 were connected to a different tank battery from the one indicated in the application, dated August 26, 1964, in which it was requested that the commingling area be expanded.

In view of the greater revenue to be realized by producing the wells completed in the S/2 of Section 20 into a tank battery different from the aforementioned battery, TEXACO Inc. would appreciate cancellation of the aforementioned amendment to Order PC-29. A separate application to commingle the production from the S/2 of Section 20 with that of a different area is to follow.
