Re: Revision No. 1 For Commingled Production, Carlson Federal "A" Lease in Justis Field, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

On July 10, 1961, we were granted permission to commingle the production from three separate pools (Paddock, Blinebry & Tubb/Drinkard) on our Carlson Federal "A" Lease. This lease consists of the N/2 SE/4 of Section 23, Township 25-S, Range 37-E. Permission was granted by Administrative Order PC-34.


We are in the process of adding another well to the above-named lease, which will also produce from the Paddock, Blinebry and Tubb/ Drinkard pools. With the addition of this well we will install testing facilities as shown on attached schematic. This installation will permit the testing of individual wells.

We realize that the Commission's decision in Case No. 2356 may require a change in our hook-up. However, it is necessary that we proceed with the installation of enough additional equipment at this time in order to produce our new well. Our proposed installation is designed to require a minimum of revision at a later date.

Re: Permission to commingle the production from three separate pools and to use a common power oil supply for artificial lift on the Carlson Federal "A" Lease in Justis Field, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

The applicant, The Atlantic Refining Company, requests permission to commingle the production from three separate pools (Paddock, Blinebry, and Tubb-Drinkard) into a common tank battery on the Carlson Federal "A" Lease in Justis Field. Applicant seeks permission as per Revised Rule 303, Case No. 1850, Order No. R 1957. Also applicant requests permission to use a common power oil supply for artificial lift when needed when the wells quit flowing.

The applicant is the operator of the Carlson Federal "A" Lease which consists of the N/2 SE/4 of Section 23, Township 25-S, Range 37-E. Each pool will be produced as a single common source of supply. The completed wells will be maintained and operated so as to prevent communication within the wellbore and before marketing. The liquid hydrocarbon production from each zone will be determined prior to commingling. The gravities of the hydrocarbons and the values thereof from each pool and the expected gravity and value of the commingled hydrocarbon are as follows:

There should not be any loss in value due to commingling. If the intermediate hydrocarbons from any of the zones is sour, separate tankage will be installed for that zone.

Attached is a schematic drawing of the proposed tank battery for this lease with the additional equipment for artificial lift. Without the need for artificial lift the hydrocarbons will go directly from the treating system to the storage tanks. This proposal will permit the use of common storage tanks with the liquid hydrocarbons determined separately prior to commingling with meters equipped with non-reset totalizers. Samplers will be installed on each zone so as to attribute the bad oil to the proper zone. After commingling, the water will be removed in a common treating system. The net liquid hydrocarbons will be determined from the metered volumes and the samples obtained. At such time as the water production from any pool becomes too large for accurate metering, a free water knock-out can be installed upstream of the meter.

When the wells cease to flow by natural means, we propose to install hydraulic pumps in each zone using a common power oil supply. The power oil will be metered to each zone. The combined power oil and production from each zone will be metered and sampled prior to commingling.

All persons owning an interest in the subject acreage are being notified by registered mail as per attached list.


The proposed installation will permit the applicant to conduct tests of the individual wells. Approval of this proposal will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.


