## Gentlemen:

Texaco Inc. respectfully requests permission to surface commingle Justis Tubb Drinkard pool production from the C. E. Penny Fed. (NCT-4) Well No. 4 with Justis Blinebry and Langlie Mattix pool production on the subject lease.

Currently Justis Blinebry and Langlie Mattix pool production are surface commingled on the subject lease under Commingling Order PC-49. This order was ammended on April 6, 1972 to delete the Justis Tubb Drinkard because it was no longer productive. However, Justis Tubb Drinkard pool production is being reestablished on the subject lease due to current remedial work on Well No. 4. Well No. 4 will make an estimated marginal production of 69 BOPD, 70 BWPD and 105 MCFPD from the Justis Tubb Drinkard. Oil prices will not be changed due to this requested commingling. Allocation of production will continue to be made by individual well tests. A schematic of the subject commingled battery is attached. (The adjacent Justis Ellenburger battery is also shown.)

In view of the above mentioned facts, Texaco Inc. respectfully requests that Commingling Order PC-49 be amended to allow surface commingling of Justis Tubb Drinkard with Justis Blinebry and Langlie Mattix pool production.
