Gentlemen:

We are currently commingling Devonian and Wolfcamp production on our Priest lease (Section I, T-I5-S, R-37-E), Lea County, New Mexico. Wolfcamp production is separately metered and Devonian production is determined by the subtraction method.

At present, all wells on the lease are marginal with no well capable of top allowable production. Therefore, we request permission to commingle production on the subject lease without separate metering. Allocation of production would be made on the basis of monthly well tests. The proposed change would allow us to retire some equipment from the lease for use in other operations.

In support of our request we are submitting a schematic of the proposed installation and a tabulation of well production for a 60-day period. The installation will continue to be operated in accordance with the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
