Re: Administrative Order PC-54

Continental Oil Company was granted permission by Administrative Order PC-54, dated January 8, 1962, to commingle oil production from the Drinkard and Hare Pools and distillate production from the Elinebry and Tubb Gas Pools on its Wantz Lease, located in Section 21, T-21S, R-37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Recently, commercial production was established from the Elinebry Oil Pool on the Wantz Lease. Continental Oil Company now requests an amendment to Administrative Order PC-54 to permit commingling of Elinebry oil with the Drinkard and Hare oil and distillate production from the Elinebry and Tubb Gas Pools.

The present commingled production is approximately 44 BOPD with a gravity of 43.7° API. The expected commingled production will be approximately 185 BOPD with a gravity of 40.4° API. There will be no increase or decrease in revenue due to the commingling.

The attached schematic diagram indicates the manner in which the production will be commingled.

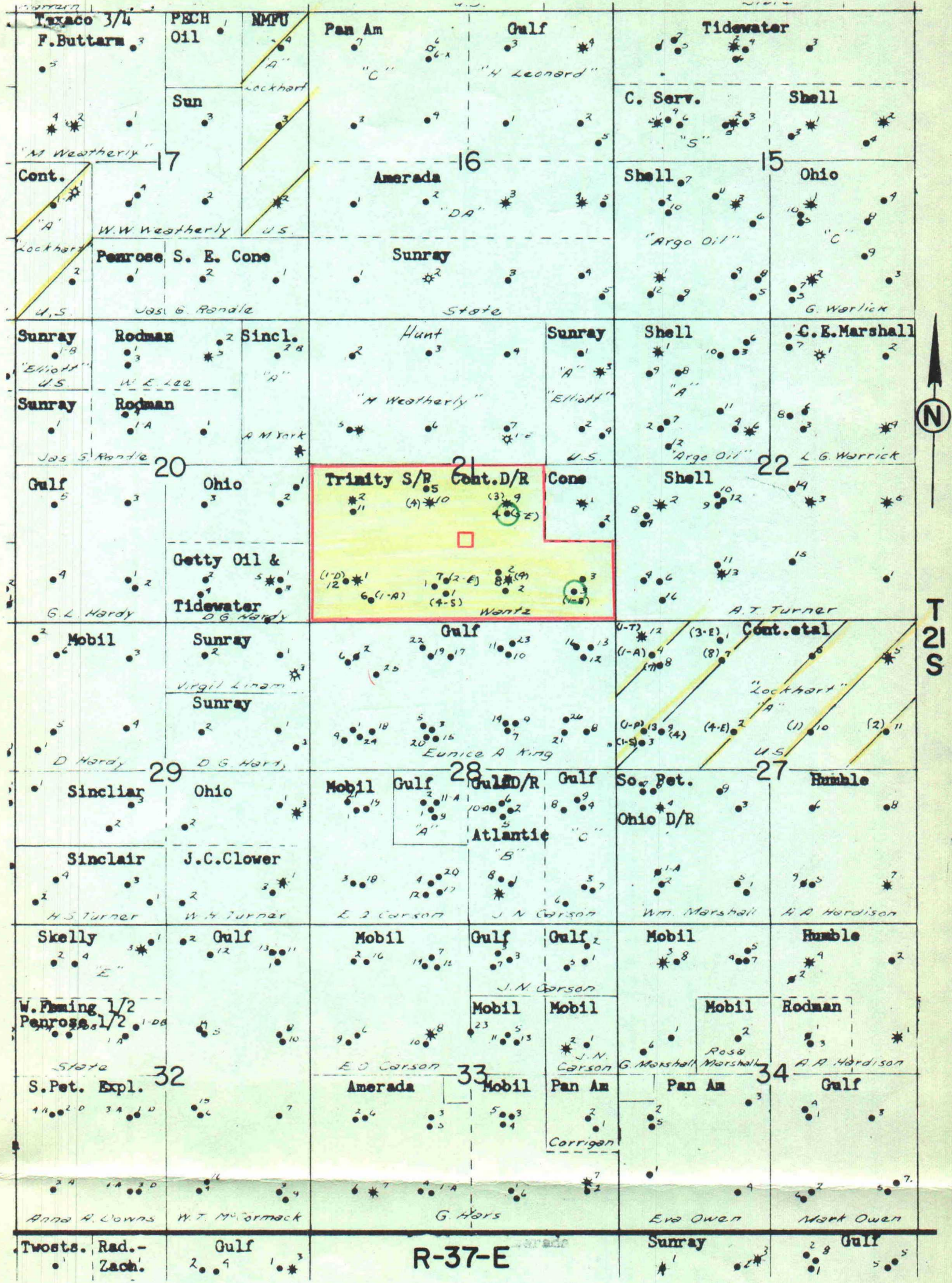
