Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated January 9, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the North Justis-Fusselman Pool, North Justis-McKee Pool, North Justis-Tubb Drinkard Pool, an adjacent North Justis-Elzenburger Pool, an adjacent North Justis-Blinbry Pool, and an undesignated Paddock pool on your State NJ "A" Lease located in Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the North Justis-Fusselman Pool, North Justis-McKee Pool, North Justis-Tubb Drinkard Pool, an adjacent North Justis-Elzenburger Pool, an adjacent North Justis-Blinbry Pool, and an undesignated Paddock pool on the above-described State NJ "A" Lease after separately metering the production from each pool; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
