Reference is made to your application dated February 6, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Dean-Devonian and Dean Permian-Pennsylvanian Pools on your State "AN" Lease located in Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, without separately metering the production from each pool.
