
Description: S/2 N/2 and N/2 S/2 of Section 12, T-20S,
R-37E, NMPM, Lea County, NM

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Skaggs-Glorieta, East Weir-Blinebry, Monument Tubb, Skaggs-Drinkard and Undesignated Abo pool production in a common tank battery and to determine the liquids production from each pool by well tests. (If this method is to be authorized, all commingled production must be of marginal nature; further the operator shall notify the Santa Fe Office the Division in the event any well in the commingled battery becomes capable of top allowable production, at which time the Division will amend this order or take such other action as may be appropriate.)

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The previous amended Order PC-83 allowed for the commingling of the Undesignated Abo Pool with the other pools, with the exception that production be metered separately. This amendment allows liquids production determination by well tests but, requires Undesignated Abo gas to be measured separately.
