Reference is made to your letter of June 22, 1962, requesting authority to commingle the Blinbry and Eunice production from your Bell Ramsey (NCT-A) Lease comprising the W/2 W/2 of Section 4 and the W/2 W/2 of Section 9, both in Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from the Blinbry Pool. 36
