Administrative Order PC-87**

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated June 19, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-87 which permitted the commingling of Blinebry and Eunice production on your Bell Ramsay (NCT-A) Lease, after separately metering the production from the Blinebry Pool and determining the Eunice production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that the Blinebry wells have declined to a marginal status and that you wish the order be amended to eliminate the metering requirement for the Blinebry zone.

Administrative Order PC-87 is hereby amended in the above-described manner, provided however, that you shall notify the Commission at any time that any well in either pool is capable of top allowable production. The order in all other respects will remain in full force and effect.
