Reference is made to your letter of January 7, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-91 which order authorized the commingling of oil production from the Brunson, Drinkard, and Hare Pools and liquid hydrocarbon production from the Blinebry and Tubb Gas Pools on your Hawk B-10 Lease after separately measuring the Blinebry, Tubb, and Hare production and allocating the production to the Brunson and the Drinkard Pools on the basis of quarterly tests. It is our understanding that you now have top allowable Wantz-Abo production on said lease and that you wish to include it in the commingling authority, separately measuring the Wantz-Abo prior to the commingling. Blinebry, Tubb, Wantz-Abo, and Brunson production would be metered separately and Drinkard and Hare production continue to be determined by means of the subtraction method and quarterly tests.

Administrative Order PC-91 is hereby amended to include the Wantz-Abo production on your Hawk B-10 Lease in the commingling authority contained therein. In all other respects, Administrative Order PC-91 will remain in full force and effect.
