Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated July 9, 1962, wherein you request administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of production from the North Justis Tubb-Drinkard, North Justis-Devonian and North Justis-Fusselman Pools on your C. C. Fristoe (b) NCT-2 Lease located in Section 26 and Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from all but the North Justis-Devonian Pool and determining said North Justis-Devonian production by means of the subtraction method. We have now received consent to such commingling from the United States Geological Survey.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
