Reference is made to your application dated December 5, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of condensate from the Mesaverde formation and from the Dakota formation on your H. K. Riddle Dakota Gas Unit comprising the E/2 of Section 9, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, allocating the production from each zone on the basis of periodic condensate ratio tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Administrative Order No. 1-1-1

Reference is made to your application dated May 10, 1933, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 10, of the Commission Rules and Regulations, to permit the removal of condensate from the Messavie, formation and from the Bakken formation on your M. K. Middle Verde Gas Unit, comprising the 1/2 of Section 8, Township 34 North, Range 1 East, San Juan County, New Mexico, requesting the protection of such zone on the basis of periodic condensate rates.
