Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated January 18, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Rattlesnake zone oil production and Hogback zone condensate production, Rattlesnake Field, San Juan County, New Mexico, on your Navajo Lease comprising portions of Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, and 24, Township 29 North, Range 19 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Hogback zone condensate and determining the Rattlesnake production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
