Amendment Administrative Order PC-131

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated October 11, 1965, wherein you request authority to commingle the oil production from the Pennsylvanian "B" and the Pennsylvanian "CD" reservoirs in a common production treater, allocating the production to each of the zones on the basis of periodic tests. We assume that this is the same installation authorized for commingling by Administrative Order PC-131 wherein Continental was authorized to commingle Rattlesnake zone oil production and Hogback zone condensate production after separately metering the Hogback condensate and determining the Rattlesnake production by means of the subtraction method.

Inasmuch as all production from both zones is of marginal nature, Administrative Order PC-131 is hereby amended, provided, however, that the production from each zone shall be separately metered and separated, since commingled, and treated.
