Humble Oil & Refining Company requests permission to commingle oil production from the Granite Wash Oil Pool (Undesignated) with the <u>Blinebry Oil and Drinkard</u> Oil Pool on its New Mexico State "S" Lease, comprising all of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Drinkard oil averages 38.5° API gravity, classed as intermediate sweet, with a posted price of \$2.97 per barrel. Blinebry oil averages 41.3° API, classed as intermediate sweet, with a posted price of \$3.01 per barrel. The Granite Wash Oil from recently tripled New Mexico State "S" Well No. 24 has a gravity of 38.6° API, classed as sweet, with a posted price of \$3.01 per barrel. There will be no monetary gain or loss due to commingling. The Granite Wash Oil will be provided with metering and sampling facilities prior to commingling with Drinkard and Blinebry Oil at New Mexico State "S" Battery No. 5.



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
