Administrative order PC-157

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of January 8, 1964, requesting an amendment to Administrative Order PC-137 to permit the commingling of Wantz-Abo, Blinebry, Wantz Granite Wash, and Drinkard production on your New Mexico State "5" Lease allocating the production to each pool on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that the production from all of the aforesaid pools is now of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-137 is hereby amended to delete the separate metering requirements for the Blinebry, Wantz Granite Wash, and Wantz-Abo Pools, provided however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production. Wells in each pool shall be tested on a quarterly basis until further notice.
