You therefore request that the subject Administrative Order be amended to delete the requirement for metering production prior to commingling.

Administrative Order PC-143 is hereby amended to provide for allocation of production to the commingled pools on the basis of periodic well tests, provided however, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well producing into the facility becomes capable of top allowable production.
