Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated June 10, 1965, for an amendment to Administrative Order PC-145 which order authorizes the commingling of Skaggs-Glorieta, Skaggs-Drinkard, East Weir-Blinbry, and Eumont oil production and distillate from the Eumont Gas Pool on your Skaggs B-12 Lease after separately metering the Glorieta, Blinbry and Drinkard production and allocating the Eumont oil and distillate production by means of the subtraction method and periodic well tests.

It is our understanding that you now wish to add Monument Tubb production to the commingling installation. Said Tubb production being separately metered and the Eumont, Skaggs, East Weir-Blinbry, and Drinkard production being determined by the subtraction method, allocation to each of the various wells and pools on the basis of periodic well tests.

Inasmuch as all of the aforesaid production, with the exception of the Monument Tubb, is of marginal nature, Continental Oil Company is hereby authorized to revise the commingling installation as described above, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.
