Amendment
Administrative Order PC-147

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of July 7, 1964, wherein you request authority to commingle Vacuum Upper Pennsylvanian production on your "GO" State "P" Lease in Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, with the commingled Glorieta, Blinbry, Abo and Wolfcamp, which is presently being commingled under authority of Administrative Order PC-147.

Administrative Order PC-147 authorized the commingling of the aforesaid zones with Devonian production in the Vacuum Field. Inasmuch as your schematic diagram shows no Devonian production being handled in this installation, it is assumed that in effect your request should be for an amendment to Administrative Order PC-147 to substitute Upper Pennsylvanian production for Devonian production in said order.

Administrative Order PC-147 is so amended. Provided, however, that it shall remain in full force and effect in all other respects.
