AMENDMENT  
Administrative Order PC-147

O Gentlemen:

P Reference is made to your application for amendment of Administrative Order PC-147 which, as amended, authorizes the commingling of Glorieta, Blinbry, Abo, Wolfcamp, and Upper Pennsylvanian production from your State "F" Lease in Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. It is our understanding that the designation of this lease has now been changed to State "BA" Lease and that you propose to commingle said production without metering, inasmuch as all wells in each pool on said lease have declined to marginal status.

Y Administrative Order PC-147, as amended, is hereby further amended to delete the metering requirement prior to commingling, provided that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well on this lease does again become capable of top allowable production.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for extension of Administrative Order 10-157, as amended, regarding the commingling of Hobbs, Blinman, and other oil companies production from your lease "B" located in the 36, Township 12 North, Range 36 East, Town 6 North, New Mexico, after successfully meeting the production from each pool. It is our understanding that the designation of this lease has now been changed to State "B" lease. In that we propose to terminate this production without action, in that as all wells in each pool on said lease have been shut in, marginal status.

Administrative Order 10-157, as amended, is hereby further amended to allow the lessee to terminate the lease on condition provided that the lessee shall submit a report to the Commission any well on said lease shall become subject to the same rules and regulations.
