Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of June 5, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-169 dated Nevember 13, 1963, as amended by our letter of May 19, 1964. The amended order in effect at the present time authorizes the commingling of Blinebry oil, Blinebry and Tubb gas well liquids, and Drinkard oil on your Lockhart A-35 Lease, after separately matering the Blinebry oil and the combined Blinebry and Tubb gas well distillates, determining the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.

It is our understanding that due to a diversity of interest, the Tubb gas well liquids will not be included in the commingling installation, and that you now propose to commingle only Blinebry gas well liquids, Drinkard oil, and Blinebry oil, after separately measuring the Blinebry gas well liquids and the Drinkard oil, and determining the Blinebry oil by means of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order PC-169 is hereby amended to permit the aforesaid commingling in the above-described manner.
