Administrative Order PC-173

## Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated January 19, 1968, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-173 which authorizes the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard oil and Blinebry and Tubb distillate on your Lockhart B-35 Lease which comprises the ME/4 of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry oil from Wells Nos. 3 and 4, Blinebry distillate from Well No. 2, Tubb distillate and Drinkard oil from Well No. 1, and commingling this measured production with Drinkard oil from Wells Nos. 2, 3, and 4, determining this latter Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that Drinkard Well No. 2 has now been abandoned and recompleted as an Abo producer and that you therefore propose to commingle the Abo production with the aforesaid commingled production after separately metering the Abo production.

Administrative Order PC-173 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Abo production from your Lockhart B-35 Well No. 2 after separate measurement. Further, said order is also amended to delete the requirement for metering the Blinebry oil production from Wells Nos. 3 and 4, inasmuch as said wells are now of marginal nature. Administrative Order PC-173 is, in all other respects, to remain in full force and effect.
