Reference is made to your application dated November 20, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinebry and Glorieta production on your State "I" Lease comprising the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the Glorieta production by means of the subtraction method.
