Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests an exception to Rule 303 and administrative approval to commingle the oil produced from the Drinkard and Queen Pools on the J. H. McClure "B" Lease, Section 19 & 30, T-24-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico. It is requested that commingling be allowed without separately measuring the production from each pool. All the wells are physically incapable of producing top allowable and they are commonly owned.

The following is a tabulation of recent production:

Drinkard	1872	62	1958	63
Queen	196	7	216	7

The API gravities and the respective values of the oils are shown below:

Pool	API Gravity	Value per Bbl.
Drinkard	35.7°	\$2.91
Queen	29.6°	2.79

The gravity of the commingled production is expected to be 35.1° API with a value of \$2.91 per barrel which is not less than the sum of the two crudes.

Verbal approval has been given by Texas New Mexico Pipe Line Company for commingling and a copy of this letter will be mailed to them.

The attached plat and schematic diagram shows the location of all wells on the subject lease, the pools from which each well is producing and the proposed tank battery arrangement. Also attached is a copy of a letter to the U.S.G.S. requesting permission for the installation.


